

ORGANIC AGRICULTURE AND BUSINESS SECTOR

The main results we are proud of:



More than **665 farmers** trained in using principles, equipment and technologies in organic agriculture, and obtaining organic certification



More than **20 grants** offered to farmers for postharvest processing, equipment, and marketing and promotional activities



More than **30 trainings** and study visits organised for farmers, involving national and international experts



2 associations of farmers, processors and consumers of organic products supported



More than **30 individual coaching sessions** provided to farmers by local and foreign experts



3 agricultural colleges provided with trainings for teachers and students, exchange of experience and financial support for improving college facilities and equipment



55 cereal producers, possessing a total surface of 7 000 hectares, are certified organic or in conversion



More than **20 grants** offered to small and medium-sized enterprises from the North region of Republic of Moldova

How do we support this sector?

- ightarrow provide knowledge and know-how transfer to farmers interested in organic agriculture;
- ightarrow promote the demand of organic products on domestic markets and encourage exports of organic products;
- \rightarrow support small and medium-sized enterprises and start-up sector in the North of the country.

SOCIAL INCLUSION OF PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES

The main results we are proud of:



4 psycho-neurological institutions for adults from Bădiceni, Brânzeni, Cocieri villages and Bălți municipality supported throughout the transformation process



The **social service sheltered housing** created and piloted for people with disabilities who left psycho-neurological institutions



30 students from social assistance and psychology departments involved in the Winter School and trained in new methods of providing inclusive social services and in advocacy



- → reduce stigmatization of people with disabilities;
- ightarrow offer alternatives to residential care of adults with disabilities by creating the social service sheltered housing;
- \rightarrow promote inclusion together with public authorities and communities.



4 Social Inclusion Strategies for the years 2018-2021 developed together with the local public authorities from Dubăsari, Edineţ, Soroca districts and Bălti municipality



12 small grants offered to local NGOs from Dubăsari, Edineţ, Soroca districts and Bălţi municipality for implementing the Social Inclusion Strategies



4 local inclusion groups created and strengthened in Dubăsari, Edineţ, Soroca districts and Bălţi municipality



40 members of local inclusion groups informed about alternative social services through 2 study visits to the Czech Republic and 24 local workshops



4 assessments regarding the needs for developing inclusive social services carried out in 4 districts



4 mappings of existing social services realised in Dubăsari, Edineţ, Soroca districts and Bălţi municipality.

CIVIL SOCIETY EMPOWERMENT AND GOOD GOVERNANCE

The main results we are proud of:



More than **5000 students from over 200 schools** involved in optional classes "Education through Documentaries"



More than **350 teachers** trained in using documentaries during classes



The Curriculum for optional classes "Education through Documentaries" approved by the Ministry and updated, and 2 methodological guidelines for teachers printed



More than **70 young people** trained on how to become film club leaders

How do we support this sector?

- → promote documentaries as an innovation in education;
- \rightarrow encourage civic activism, critical thinking, and local initiatives of young people;
- \rightarrow support rural development in a new format, based on the LEADER approach from the European Union.



More than **20 documentaries** included in the programme of optional classes "Education through Documentaries" and in the film clubs' programme



More than **150 film screenings** realised by young people in their communities



4 Summer Schools organised for 80 young people



More than **20 small grants** offered to young people for realising local change initiatives



4 study visits organised in the Czech Republic for students and teachers



2 Local Action Groups created and supported in Strășeni and Anenii Noi districts, involving local public administration, private sector, and civil society organisations.

3 Information and Legal Centres created in Tiraspol, Dubăsari and Râbniţa



Free legal aid and informational support provided to people, initiative groups, civil society organisations



3 Citizens' Clubs #19 created in Tiraspol, Dubăsari and Râbnița (number 19 refers to the Article 19 of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, which refers to the right to freedom of opinion and expression)



1 Youth Information Resource Centre created in Tighina



Documentary film screenings, exhibitions, public discussions and debates organised by the Citizens' Clubs in order to raise the level of civic education and engagement in the society



1 Paralegal network created to provide legal aid for people from 8 villages



The **Documentary Film Festival "Chesnok"**, a unique cultural event in the Transnistrian region, organised since 2016.
